CONTINUOUS SPARRING

Each match will be 2- 1 minute rounds with a 30 second rest period. Points will be added at the end of both rounds to declare the winner. It is the Referee's decision to disqualify an opponent for any reason after 1 warning of any excessive contact. All judges and referee decisions are final in each ring. Any competitor who causes a knockout will be disqualified immediately.

CONTINUOUS GEAR

- Head Gear
- Mouthpiece
- Foam Hand Gear
- Men-Groin Cup
- Women-Pelvic Protection/Optional
- Foam Shin Guard/Optional
- Foam Foot Gear

RULES

No knees or elbows are allowed. All kicks will be above the belt. The targeted areas are as follows: Controlled punches to the face. Back-fist or ridge-hands are the only techniques allowed to the head gear area only. The head, chest, stomach, and ribs are the targeted areas only. Jumping and flying front and turning kicks are the only kicks allowed in continuous sparring.

ILLEGAL TARGETS

No contact is allowed to the eyes, throat or neck. A controlled kick is allowed to the back of the head, as long as the kick is on the head gear area only. No contact to the back. No groin contract, nothing below the belt.

SCORING Points

Punch to the Head	1
Jump Punch to the Head	2
Kick to the Body	1
Kick to the Head	2
Jump Kick to the Body	2
Jump Kick to the Head	3

TKD SPARRING

All competitors will use Modified WTF rules and guidelines. Each match will be 2-1 minute rounds with a 30 second rest periods. If one competitor scores a 10 point spread, then the match is stopped and he or she is the winner.

WTF SPARRING GEAR

- Head Gear
- Mouthpiece
- Fist/Forearm Guards
- Chest Guard (Mandatory)
- Men-Groin Cup
- Shin/Instep Guards

GENERAL RULES

In competition, a technique is valid when: It is executed correctly, it is dynamic, that is to say it is delivered with strength, purpose, rapidity and precision, it is controlled on the target.

WARNINGS:

Warnings will be assigned for the following:

An attack to an illegal target, loss of temper, insulting an opponent in anyway, biting, scratching, and clawing ,attacking with the knee, elbow, forehead, attacking a fallen opponent, stepping completely out of the ring (both feet), falling down, whether intentional or not (this means any part of the body, other than the feet, touching the ground), holding/ grabbing/ punching, sweeping, faking a blow, pretending to be injured to gain an advantage, intentionally avoiding sparring, pretending to have scored a point by raising the arm. Note: These rules are adopted and modified from the International Tae Kwon Do Federation.

Disqualification: Referee's decision to disqualify an opponent for any reason after 1 warning of any excessive contact will be allowed. The sum of 2 warnings is a loss of a point, 3rd warning is disqualification. Rules for Bad Sportsmanship: Any obscene gestures, profanity, or excessive force from any competitor will be disqualified immediately and will be asked to leave and personally escorted to an exit door by security and/ or any tournament official.

WEAPONS

All weapon forms will be performed no more than 1 minute. No sharp weapons with an edge will be allowed. Weapon forms will be judged based on strong stances and demonstration of the weapon. Color Belt competitors are allowed 1 extra chance if the weapon is dropped during the form demonstration. All Black Belts will not be allowed to continue his or her form if the weapon is dropped. Black Belts will be allowed to use edged weapons.

FORMS COMPETITION

TKD Black Belt Open Forms – Each competitor must pick one black belt Form.
TKD Color Belt Open Forms – Each competitor must perform their current belt rank Form.
Each Competitor can choose a lower belt Form.
Karate & Kung Fu ranks will compete in Tae Kwon Do Forms Divisions.

VERIFICATION OF AGE

Every competitor under the age of 17 must have legal identification on their person at the tournament. Any referee will have the right to refuse competition to any competitor without proper I.D. This is required to help provide safety and practice good sportsmanship to all competitors.

FORMS JUDGES

There will be 2 to 4 judges seated in front of an assigned ring. Each Competitor will be given a score rated 1-10 to determine the winner.

CORNER JUDGES (SPARRING)

Each ring will have a total of 2 judges sitting diagonally from each other. These judges will be assigned either red fighter or blue fighter. At the end of the match, the referee will add the points together to determine the winner.

REFEREE

All Decisions are final in the ring by the center referee. No Exceptions.

BLACK BELT:

- 1 minute set up/minus points for any time over
- Unlimited boards
- 1 attempt to break only

COLOR BELT:

- 1 minute set up/minus points for any time over
- Up to 6 boards total
- 3 attempts total to break

Winner will be decided by number and size of boards, difficulty, and complete break of each board.
